
• DKD (Dr. Kalam Blood Donation App) Launch – July 22, 12:45 PM

• No. 20 Assam Mail – August 2

It includes dress, toothbrush, paste, sanitary napkins, bedsheets, blankets, soaps, detergents etc. The boxes were handed over to Mr. Jobin George of BPS College, Piramadom by the Principal, Dr. David Saj Mathew of the college.



• Hiroshima Day – August 6

A moment of silence for the victims of the atom bombing at Hiroshima was taken by the NSS volunteers. Sadako Sasaki Origami crane making was taught to students by one of the NSS volunteer.



• Collection Point at UCC – August 10 – 13

During the Kerala floods of 2019, Union Christian College became a main collection point for the flood affected peoples of in and around Kerala. NSS volunteers were active participants in the collection point. Materials were collected and send to Nilambur and Wayanad. 14000 dress materials, 4470 sanitary napkins, 2023 diapers, 1890 cleaning materials, 685 variety of medicines, 1250 food items, 270 mosquito coils, 121 mats, 593 toothpaste and brush, 686 soaps, 194 Kg Rice, 68 Kg different types of Cereals and 200 water bottles were collected and was handed over to the affected area.



• "Twinkle Twinkle Little Star" – August 13

"Twinkle twinkle little star – a beam of happiness" is another initiative taken by NSS unit of Union Christian College, Aluva to help the children that were affected by the flood. Online campaigning was started in order to collect toy, books, sketch pens, pencils, pens etc.

The programme was conducted jointly by NSS volunteers and teaching and non-teachings staffs of the college, to help the households affected by the 2019 floods. 50 flood affected households of Paruvakkad area of Malikampeedika, Aluva were identified and selected through surveys by the NSS volunteers. Each household was given a kit worth Rs.2000/-which was contributed by teaching staffs of the college.NSS volunteers along with the staffs actively participated in sorting and packing the items.
